Request is hereby made for the temporary release of electrical service to then subject project only for the purpose of testing equipment and/or construction power prior to final release.

I am fully aware of the provision of the Administrative Code which indicates, in part, that no building or structure shall be used or occupied until the Building Official or authorized representative has issued a certificate of use and occupancy and/or finalized the building for occupancy.

Furthermore, it is not our intent to use or occupy this building until all City of Winters regulations and conditions concerning this building have been complied with. In addition, it is understood and agreed that the jurisdiction is hereby authorized to order discontinuance of utility service for any violations of the above conditions prior to the final approval of use and occupancy. It is also understood that I will be subject to fees based on the current staff hourly rate for enforcement of any violation of the above conditions.

Temporary electrical service is to be installed as follows:

- On a temporary service pole as described in PG&E's Electrical Service Manual, or
- Supported on a wood framing that makes up the exterior wall of the structure, or
- Supported with a minimum of two 2x4's and anchored to a stem wall/grade beam or rim joist.

The temporary service must be installed and grounded as required by the 2004 California Electrical Code, i.e. 110/120 volts, receptacles must be GFCI protected with weatherproof covers, etc. Without a temporary electric service permit, PG&E will not be authorized to connect the electric service until it is necessary to check GFI circuits, such as just before occupancy.

I acknowledge the above and will be responsible for maintaining the installation in a safe condition until final acceptance.
