



## **Pierre Neu Biography**

I was born in Stockton, California. My Father was an immigrant from Luxembourg and my mother's parents emigrated from France. I attended public schools in Stockton from kindergarten through community college. I left Stockton when I was 19 to attend Fresno State College, where I earned a Bachelor of Science degree.
