2. Restoration Project Update – Rich

Waiting for winters flows to subside to do weed control. Harvested sedge and golden rod plants that were replanted in phase 3. Salmon count between diversion dam and Winters was 550. Erosion control mix comprised of sterile wheat grass and creeping wild rye. TenPass inquired about burned excavator, eucalyptus rounds and other items left on site. Rich responded that all items have been removed except excavator, SCWA is waiting for insurance clearance and road to dry up to remove it.

Per Carol- Dead beaver that was found in Phase 3 area was tested, no rabies were found, waiting for further test results.
