A. Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Winters Senior Commission on Aging Held on Wednesday, February 10, 2021

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- 1) Winters Housing Survey to Capture Senior Housing Needs: Survey is on the city website. Purpose is to determine housing needs for all ages and income groups across town. This is a requirement from the State of California. Commission has asked that survey include questions regarding the need for Assisted Living for Seniors and/or Disabled Individuals. Hope to obtain results and open findings for public comment. Formal report will then be generated. Commission to continue to advise, as indicated.
- 2) Sr. Resource Guide: Have obtained 3 quotes for cost/printing. Five donations have been identified.
- 3) Advisor Committee to FFE Fundraising: Have met to review list (s) of items to be purchased. Reviewing costs, including services and warranties. Estimated cost is \$200,000 now. A working document is being generated for ongoing modification (s), as information comes in.
- 4) Advisor Committee for Senior Center Programs: Reached out to national organizations. Located information from the *National Institute of Senior Centers*. Reviewing award packages and programming from senior centers that won awards. Eight categories reviewed: community development and leadership; cultural; fund raising; health and wellness; nutrition; special events; technology; and highlighting the arts. Moving forward, to consider characteristics of programs for cities near the same size as Winters. A common theme for success is the availability of volunteer and cash resources. Note: September is *National Senior Center Month*.
- 5) Progress on Senior Apartments: No updates.
- 6) Progress on Senior Center: No updates.
- 7) AARP Opportunities: *Discussed Community Challenge Grant* that offers funding for specific projects that make a specific social impact of either connection, wellness, economic development, safe transportation, government & senior population connections, Coronavirus recovery or inclusivity for diverse populations. Potential project types were reviewed and discussed. Application would be due mid-April. Not enough time to apply. Moving forward, consider reviewing AARP funding opportunities 3 times per year, to allow for time to apply for relevant grants, etc.
- 8) Liaison Reports:
 - Yolo Healthy Aging: Reviewing legislative agendas and the AB-Bills
 - Winters SR Foundation: No new information
 - Yolo C Commission: No new information
 - Area 4: No new information for Area 4. Talked about Winters Elder Day Council and a series of possible seminars, once COVID-19 restrictions lift
 - *Hispanic Advisory Committee:* They are changing the name of this organization. See news article today. Now a non-profit. Discussed collaboration related to senior programs in Winters.
- 9) Promotion of SNAP and VITALs: Member VanDyke to network for opportunities to promote.

10) 2021 Priorities/Other:

- •Consider priorities during our upcoming meetings in April and May:
 - *Discussed in-person Senior Commission meetings, and considerations for a possible Hybrid Format (In-person meeting, with option for Zoom-in the Room so that folks can join remotely, as an option).
 - *Discussed possible outreach programs & inter-generational programs for Seniors and School-Age Children, and outreach programs for Senior Support/Needs (Example: pet care)
- •Discussed Town Hall Meetings: Sheila Allen has grant money for Town Hall Meetings regarding a new master plan on aging for the state of CA. Legislative representatives would be in attendance to discuss potential priorities with our community. Meeting could occur via ZOOM as an option.
