

RESOLUTION 2021-21

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINTERS ADOPTING FEES AND CHARGES FOR CERTAIN SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF WINTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Winters (the “City”) charges fees for various services, permits, licenses, and regulatory activity provided by the City (collectively, the “Fees”); and

WHEREAS, in order for the Fees to cover the costs of providing the services, permits, licenses, or regulatory activity for which the Fees are imposed, many of the Fees must be adjusted to reflect reasonable estimated costs of service; and

WHEREAS, certain Fees are subject to the adoption procedures set forth in Government Code section 66016, and others are subject to the procedures set forth in Government Code section 66018; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code section 66016, the City has made available to the public at least ten days prior to its public hearing, data supporting the Fees, and notice of this hearing has been mailed to all interested persons that have requested such notice at least 14 days prior to the date of this hearing; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code section 66018, the City Council called a public hearing for April 20, 2021, for informational purposes and to receive public comments on the proposed Fees. Notice of the public hearing was given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City once a week for two weeks commencing at least 10 days prior to the public hearing, with at least 5 days intervening between the first and last publication. On April 20, 2021, at the time and place set for the public hearing, the City Council heard and considered all oral and written presentations and comments made regarding the proposed Fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now wishes to adopt the new or increased Fees set forth in Exhibit A, effective July 1, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Winters does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. The above Recitals are true and correct and by this reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby adopts the new or increased fees set forth in the City of Winters Fee Schedules “A” through “F” described in Exhibit “A” attached hereto. The Fees imposed by this Resolution shall take effect on July 1, 2021, and shall supersede any prior fees or charges imposed by resolution or otherwise by the City Council, to the extent such prior fees or charges conflict herewith.

SECTION 3. The City Council previously adopted fees in Resolution 2017-35, which requires that each fee adopted by Resolution 2017-35 in Schedules “A” through “F” be adjusted automatically on July 1 of each year beginning July 1, 2018. The City Council elected to waive collection of the automatic inflationary adjustment for the period July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2021 due to the economic effect of the COVID-19

pandemic on families and businesses. The City Council affirms that it will resume collection of the automatic adjustments previously approved by Resolution 2017-35 beginning July 1, 2021.

SECTION 4. “Schedule G’ – Recreation Fees” in Section 3 of Resolution 2017-35 shall be relettered “Schedule F’ – Recreation Fees”.

SECTION 5. The City Council called a public hearing on April 20, 2021, for the purpose of receiving public comments to the proposed Fees. Notice of the public hearing was given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City once a week for two weeks commencing at least 10 days prior to the public hearing, with at least 5 days intervening between the first and last publication. On April 20, 2021, at the time and place set for the public hearing, the City Council heard and considered all oral and written presentations and comments made regarding the proposed Fees.

SECTION 6. The maximum rate for the Fees set forth in Schedules “A,” “B,” “D” “E” and “F” (excluding Fees that are based on building valuation) shall be adjusted each July 1, commencing July 1, 2022, by the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) as of December of such year, provided that if such index shall cease to exist, the City may determine the appropriate increase based on a comparable index. With respect to Fees based set forth in Schedule “C” relating to Public Works/Engineering, those Fees shall be adjusted each July 1 by the percentage increase in the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index (City Cost Index, San Francisco) as of December of such year, provided that if such index shall cease to exist, the City may determine the appropriate increase based on a comparable index. With respect to Fees based on building valuation, the valuation for buildings shall be established based on the International Building Code, as such index shall be updated from time to time.

SECTION 7. The City Council finds and determines that:

(a) The Fees established by this resolution:

(1) are imposed for a specific government service provided directly to the payor, or for reasonable regulatory costs of the City for issuing licenses and permits, performing investigations, inspections, and administrative enforcement of the City’s Municipal Code or other rules or ordinances;

(2) are no more than necessary to cover the reasonable costs of the governmental activity for which the Fee is imposed; and

(3) the manner in which those costs are allocated to a payor bear a fair or reasonable relationship to the payor’s burdens on, or benefits received from, the governmental activity for which the Fee is imposed; and

(b) The Fees are not taxes within the meaning of California Constitution article XIII C, section 1(e).

SECTION 8. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase in this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is for any reason held invalid, the validity of the remainder of this resolution or the application of such provision to other

persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be held invalid.

Fees include the Building Permit fee, Electrical Permit Fee, Mechanical Permit Fee and Plumbing Permit Fee.

For new construction, a valuation of the construction contract amount or the City's Building Valuations, whichever is higher shall be used.

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Schedule A - Building Permit Fees

Plan Check Fee

The Plan check Fee shall be 69.5% of the Building Permit Fee for Single Family Residential Permits

The Plan check Fee for all other Construction shall be 79.5%

The Plan check fee shall cover the Plan check, the energy plan check and the disabled access plan check in the fee charged

CARF (Capital Asset Recovery Fee)

The CARF shall be 3% of the Building permit Fee

Fire Department Review and Inspection Fee

The Fire Department Review and Inspection Fee shall be set at 11% of Building permit fee

Building Valuations

Building Valuations shall be determined by the ICC (International Code Council) Building Valuation Data Currently published modified by 1.12, the regional modifier published by ICC in 2004 (112% of the Valuation listed on the table).

Scanning Charge

Scanning Fees for construction documents over 11 x 17 shall be \$.34 per page of plans

Construction Water

A fee of 12/100 of one percent (.12%) of the construction valuation shall be collected on new construction.
