PRESENTATIONS

- Presentation by Brandon Villegas of RISE, Inc. The presentation was started by an Ice Breaker activity called Lightning Hunt. RISE stands for Rural Innovations in Social Economics. He shared the Mission, Vision and Values of the organization and the services, referrals and assistance they provide: Cal-fresh, housing, STEAC, Salvation Army, HEAP, legal, unemployment, copies, fax and computer usage. They have offices in Esparto and Winters and WIOA only in Woodland. The programs they offer are food assistance working with Eat Well Yolo and Yolo Food Bank, IMPACT parent program, DUEL youth program, Girls and Boys Group, WIOA (Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act). He also mentioned later in the meeting about a collaboration with UC Davis.
- Presentation by Viridiana Hernandez-Leon of Yolo County Library. Yolo county has library services in Winters, Davis and Esparto and has Spanish speaking staff. They offer and host various programs: Bilingual Storytime, ESL, Dia de los Niños, Plant a Flower Day and Summer Reading Program. They will be starting citizenship classes, the Aguafresca Series and Fiesta de Colores. Members Jesse Loren and Leticia commented on collaborating with the library for the citizenship services.
