PUBLIC COMMENTS/COMMUNITY LIAISON ROUNDTABLE:

- Jose Hermosillo-Winters Police Department: Officer Hermosillo announced that WPD is planning on holding an event to interact more with the Latino population. They have previously done “Coffee with a Cop”. This event will be called “Let’s Talk About It”. He would like to have this event at El Pueblo and is currently in talks with the owner. The date will be Sunday June 5th and the time is TBD. Officer Hermosillo will forward the flier to Irene for distribution to HAC members once the event has been finalized. Members of HAC and RISE, Inc. would also like to participate.
- Brandon Villegas-RISE, Inc.: Brandon announced that RISE, Inc. is starting their Summer Youth Program that is free of charge to youth in the community. This program addresses the needs assessment showing that programs for youth are needed. Activities include field trips and trips to the pool. Signups are happening now and he will forward the flier to Irene for distribution to HAC members.
- Cheryl Sandoval-Winters Senior Commission: Cheryl is our new liaison for the commission. She reported that they are gathering info from seniors on what kinds of activities they would like to see in the community. It is available in English and Spanish and can be completed online via the city website or on paper. So far they have identified a need for exercise and fitness classes, computer education, learning languages and

transportation. They have already done booths at two local and recent events. She is asking for help and ideas for the distribution of the survey. HAC members advised Cheryl of the upcoming Festival de la Comunidad in September and to forward a link to the survey to Irene for distribution to the committee. Brandon from RISE,Inc also suggested that a flier about the survey be included in the food giveaways and for those who come into their resource center.
