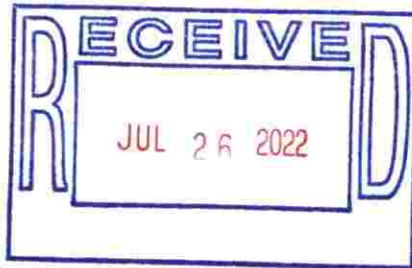
EDUCATIONS AND QUALIFICATIONS: (Word count of statement begins after this heading)
