

Bill is currently serving as Winters Mayor. He was elected to a 4-year term on the Winters City Council in June of 2016 and a second term in March 2020. He served as Mayor from July 2018 through April 2020. He served as Mayor Pro tempore from June 2016 through July 2018 and again from April 2020 through December 2022.

Bill has served on the Winters Planning Commission for 5 years, selected as Chair for 4 of those 5 prior to serving as a Council member. He is committed to furthering economic development, preservation of our historic downtown areas, improving access to programs and services for people of all abilities as well as maintaining our "small-town" feel. A partial listing of committee assignments includes Winters Downtown Business Association, LAFCO, City/County 2 x 2, Affordable Housing Steering Committee and the Design Review Committee. Past committee assignments have included Economic Development Advisory Committee, Winters Parking committee, Winters Putah Creek Park Committee, Natural Resource Commission, WJUSD/City 2x2 as well as others.

He was born and raised in Winters and has lived there almost all of his life. Bill attended Winters schools and graduated from Winters High School. He earned an Associate of Arts Degree from Yuba College and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agriculture from California State University, Chico.

Bill has been involved with agriculture all his life, first working on his family's ranch, then for local Winters farmers. He retired from the University of California Davis after working there for more than 31 years as an agricultural researcher.
