REFLECTIVE ADDRESS SIGN PROGRAM

Emergency officials can't find you if they can't see you.

Reflective address signs help ensure that first responders can stay oriented, day or night, in your neighborhood. These reflective signs are visible under smoky conditions and are 6" x 24" UV resistant metal with 4" white numbers.

The CWPP: What It Is

The Yolo County Community Wildfire Protection Plan is a strategic plan developed by the Yolo County Fire Safe Council and the Yolo County Office of Emergency Services with input from CALFIRE, local government agencies, and the community.

A Community Wildfire Protection Plan:

- is developed to reduce wildfire risk at all scales and levels of land ownership with community input and engagement
- is designed to mitigate and prepare for wildfire risk in the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI)
- recommends actions including fuels treatments, road improvements, evacuation planning, and prescribed fire to reduce risks.

All CWPPs are required to have these components:

Our Progress: Yolo County's CWPP

- 1 Form A Fire Safe Council:** The Yolo County Fire Safe Council (YCFSC) is composed of diverse stakeholders and coordinated by the Yolo County RCD. YCFSC stakeholders contribute to the CWPP.
- 2 Support the Formation of Community FSCs:** The YCFSC is working to support community FSCs, which are grassroots, citizen-led groups. New fire safe councils in the County are: the Capay Valley FSC and the West Winters FSC.
- 3 Complete a CWPP:** The first draft of the Yolo County Community Wildfire Protection Plan is complete. Stakeholders from the YCFSC will comment and edit.
- 4 Approve the CWPP:** The Yolo County CWPP must be approved and signed by local government, local fire authorities and CALFIRE. Spring 2023.
- 5 Start the Action Plan:** Having a countywide CWPP in place opens up funding opportunities for vegetation management, chipping programs and other fuel reduction projects.

- Coordination of free pump efficiency testing (tests are limited, one per grower).
